**RESOLUTION ORDERING PREPARATION OF FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR
WENTWORTH AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT 17-7**

WHEREAS, it is proposed to improve Wentworth Avenue from Delaware Avenue to Humboldt Avenue by street reconstruction including aggregate base, bituminous surfacing, utility installation and concrete curb and gutter pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 429.011 to 429.111; and

WHEREAS, the feasibility report will recommend a course of improvement for the roadways, any utility improvements, provide a cost estimate, and preliminary assessment information.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the West St. Paul City Council that the proposed improvements be referred to Ross Beckwith, City Engineer, for study and that he is instructed to report to the Council with all convenient speed advising the Council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible and as to whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvements, and the estimated cost of the improvements as recommended.
