



In order to perform sewer work in West St. Paul, ALL contractors are required to obtain a sewer permit prior to the start of work AND must have either:

A valid Master Plumber license carrying a \$25,000 state bond from the Dept. of Labor & Industry, or

A valid Pipe-Layers card with an original plumbing code compliance bond and a SSTS business license surety bond

Additionally, all contractors must provide a Certificate of Insurance showing evidence of liability insurance and worker compensation coverage.
